
SURVEY EXAMINES COMMONLY OVERLOOKED FIRE RISKS IN THE HOUSEHOLD DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON

According to a November 2022 survey commissioned by Selective Insurance and conducted online by The Harris Poll, **85% of U.S. residents decorate for the holidays inside their homes.** 



Nearly all of those holiday decorators (97%) use at least one fire hazard -- artificial Christmas trees, real Christmas trees, string lights, battery-/electric-operated candles, real flameburning candles, 2 or more extension cords connected together, and tinsel -- when decorating inside their homes.

ROUGHLY 1 IN 4 U.S. RESIDENTS (23%) DO NOT KNOW HOW MANY SETS OF INDOOR STRING LIGHTS CAN BE SAFELY CONNECTED FOR USE.

Survey Method: This survey was conducted online within the United States by The Harris Poll on behalf of Selective Insurance from November 9-11, 2022 among 2,069 U.S. adults ages 18 and older. The sampling precision of Harris online polls is measured by using a Bayesian credible interval. For this study, the sample data is accurate to within +/- 2.8 percentage points using a 95% confidence level.
