Information We Collect

Personally Identifiable Information That You Provide To Us

We may collect limited *personally identifiable information* from you when you visit *our websites*. Most of the time we will not collect *personally identifiable information* from you unless you choose to provide it to *us* – for example, by sending an e-mail, registering for online service, participating in a survey, or responding to a feedback or "contact us" form. We Do Not Sell Your Personally Identifiable Information

We do not sell personally identifiable information obtained through our websites for marketing purposes. However, if we are pursuing the sale, merger, liquidation, dissolution or transfer all or part of our business, trade or assets we may share information about you with prospective buyers and we may sell, assign or transfer any or all personally identifiable information collected through our websites to the acquiring party. Security

We Are Serious About Security
